

# Activity Stream

The Activity Stream Magento extension adds a breath of fresh air to your store by displaying recent customers' activities. Tell your visitors what others are doing and inspire to possible actions that can be taken at your website.

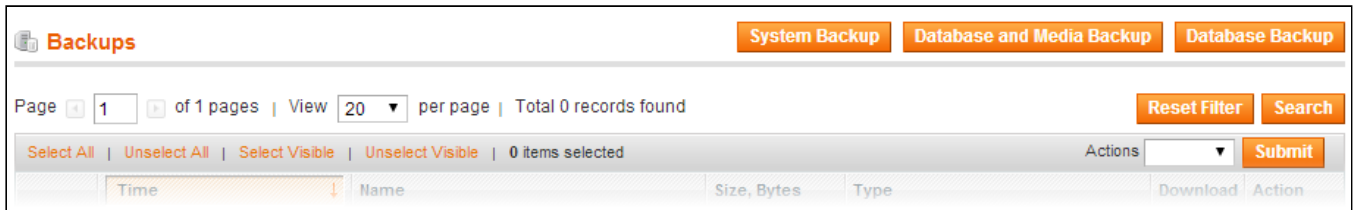
## Installation

1. Backup your web directory and store database.

You can make backup copies with any tool you find appropriate

If you are going to use the native Magento backup function, navigate to **System -> Tools -> Backups** and perform **System** and **Database** backups



2. Log in to the Magento backend

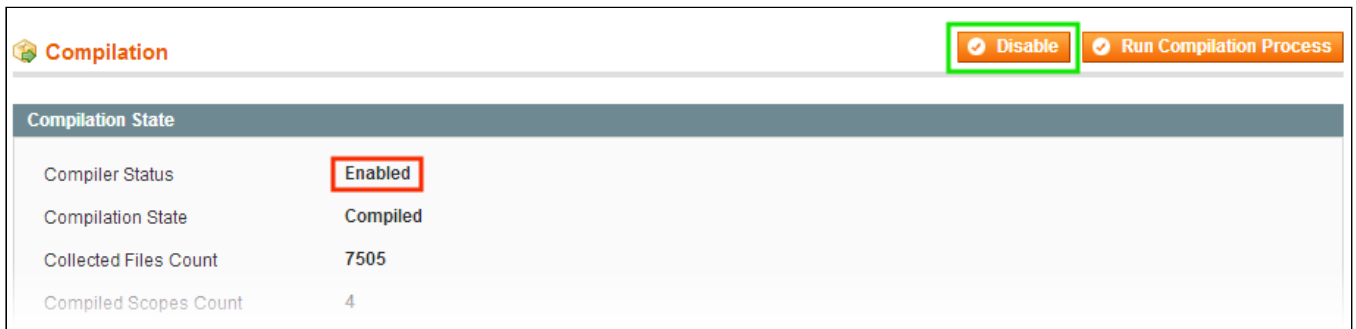
3. Disable compilation

Click to view details

Navigate to **System -> Tools -> Compilation**.

If Compiler status is Disabled, you can skip to the next step

If Compiler is enabled, disable it.



**IMPORTANT:** after the extension is installed, you can enable the compilation again; **IT IS CRUCIAL** that you use "Run Compilation Process" function, not just "Enable button"

Installing an extension with the Compilation enabled will result in store downtime.

#### 4. Flush store cache

Click to view details

You can flush the store cache in 2 ways:

- **via the backend:**

Navigate to **System -> Cache Management** menu, and click **Flush Magento Cache** button

- **via filesystem:**

On your server, navigate to Magento root folder, then proceed to **/var/cache/**; delete all the content there.

#### 5. Download the extension package from your account and extract the downloaded archive

#### 6. Copy the content of **/Step\_1/** folder to your store's root directory

##### **If you are using a custom theme,**

read the instructions [here](#).

The extension comes with 2 design packages: **/base/default/** and **/rwd/default/** .

In case you are using a custom theme, it is recommended to copy the design files to your current theme's folders. In case there are several themes in use at the same store, the design files must be copied to each of them.

- Find this folder in the package: **/step\_1/app/design/frontend/base/default/** ; copy its content to **/app/design/frontend/[your\_package]/[your\_theme]/**
- Find this folder in the package: **/step\_1/skin/frontend/base/default/** ; copy its content to **/skin/frontend/[your\_package]/[your\_theme]/**

#### 7. Copy the content of **/Step\_2/** folder to your store's root directory

#### 8. Flush store cache again; log out from the backend and log in again.

## Final step (For the stores with non-En\_US locale)

Copy the file `/app/locale/en_US/AW_Activitystream.csv` to your store locale folder(s).  
If this step is not performed, some customers activities may not be displayed correctly.

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# Configuration

All extension settings can be found in **System->Configuration->aheadWorks Extensions->Activity Stream** page. The details are below:

## General

- **Enable extension:** (Yes/No) this option has Global scope. To enable or disable the extension on a certain website or store view, use the option “**Overlay position**” (see the description below)
- **Visible to guests:** (Yes/No) – defines whether the activity stream feed is displayed for all or for registered customers only.

## Live Stream Overlay

- **Overlay Position** – Specify the position of the overlay. Setting this option to 'None' will disable the extension output for current scope.
- **Number of activities to display** - Determines how many activities to display.
- **Outer rectangle width** - The width of overlay. Allowed values range is 100 - 2000 pixels. Also it can be set in a percent of customer's browser window width. *(For example, setting this option to '50%' will always shrink overlay to a half of browser window width).*
- **Background color** - The color of overlay. Can be set with color picker, or using HTML color code: **RRGGBB**.
- **Background opacity** - Allowed value range is 10% - 100%. On mouse hovering overlay always becomes 100%-opaque.
- **Update period** - every X seconds the extension checks if there were any new events.  
*\* In case of an inaccessibility of the server the extension automatically falls into 'Safe Mode' which makes it to check for updates only every 60 seconds.*
- **Activity store filter** - Here you can specify the scope of the activities your customer can see. The options are: *Current store view, Current store, Current website, Display All.*

## Activity Types

Here you can specify which customer activities are to be displayed, and the text which will be displayed when some action is made.

When some action is made by guest, their name is displayed as 'Visitor' by default. You can change it in the locale csv file: `/app/locale/en_US/AW_Activitystream.csv`. ## Status

This is a quick diagnosis section designed to help administrators to determine reasons of most common problems fast and easily.

## Inserting Activity Stream widget

Open CMS Block or CMS page where you want to display Activity Stream widget, click 'Add widget' button and choose the following widget type: **Activity Stream**

The options are the same as on the options page (see **Configuration** section above).

Please note the following differences on the widget insert page:

- Color can not be specified with color picker tool there.
- Color code must be entered in HTML color code format: **#RRGGBB**. More information about it can be found here: [http://www.w3schools.com/html/html\\_colors.asp](http://www.w3schools.com/html/html_colors.asp)

In case you wish to customize the Activity Stream templates for the overlay and widget blocks, they can be found here:  
</app/design/frontend/default/default/template/activitystream/overlay.phtml>  
</app/design/frontend/default/default/template/activitystream/widget.phtml>

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## Uninstallation

If you require to deactivate the extension without removing it completely, go to **System->Configuration->Advanced->Advanced->Disable Modules Output** and disable the module **AW\_Activitystream**.

Also, the extension can be switched off following steps 1-5 below, without deleting the files of the extension.

1. Disable compilation, in case it is enabled.
2. Login to your FTP, navigate to **app/etc/modules/**
3. Open the file **AW\_Activitystream.xml** and change the following line:

from

```
<active>true</active>
```

to

```
<active>false</active>
```

Now your Magento is unaware of the existence of the extension.

4. Clear the cache under **var/cache**
5. Make sure that the site is working properly, otherwise roll back the changes and apply to our [technical support](#).
6. If everything works fine, it is safe to delete the files of the extension.
7. In case you need to clean the database, **make a backup** and then run the following query to MySQL server:

```
DROP TABLE `aw_activitystream_activity`;  
DELETE FROM `core_resource` WHERE `code`='activitystream_setup';
```

Note, if you are using the tables with prefixes, you have to specify them in all table names before running the query above.

- If you are not sure how to do that or expect any troubles with it, please contact your server administrator regarding the matter
  - If you remove the tables as it is described above, you will need to reconfigure the extension again after it is reinstalled.
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## Troubleshooting

**After the extension installation the store gives an error, or blank page, or suggests to start Magento installation procedure.**

Change the owner of the extracted extension files to the web server user and set 775 permissions on them. Clear the store cache and try again.

**After the extension installation I receive a 404 error in System->Configuration->Activity Stream**

Logout from backend and login back.

**The extension displays the text "{Activitystream\_CUSTOMER\_NAME\_default\_value}" instead of "Visitor"**

Make sure to copy the file /app/locale/en\_US/AW\_Activitystream.csv to the folder of your current locale.

**There is no aheadWorks extensions under my configuration section, or having the extension tab clicked I get a blank page, or Access Denied error.**

Clear the store cache, browser cookies, logout and login again.

**My configuration changes do not appear on the store.**

Clear the Magento cache, reset cache in your third-party caching software (if you have one), clear your browser cache and domain cookies and refresh the page.
